The office of the PCC has 5 staff

Patrick Geentry – Chief Constable

- The PCC made the point that the role of the Office of the PCC is 'Policing' not to Police, i.e. they are not there to instruct the Police on their daily work or operation but as a strategic body to set the objectives for policing in Wiltshire.

The PCC will cover:

- Community Safety
- Intervention
- Criminal Process
- Integration back into the community

- The PCC will cover the 20 Community Areas of Wiltshire as well as the 7 Localities of Swindon Borough

- All area board meetings will be attended by one representative of the PCC office in order to both gain and disseminate information

- The draft plan of the PCC will be released on 18th February 2013 and will be available for comment until 10th March

- The final plan will be published on 28th March 2013

- The PCC is pledging to put victims and witnesses first and will be working closely with victim support.

- Aim to reduce level of offending and reoffending

- The Wiltshire Compact are in talks with the PCC to get them to sign up
