Laura's notes from the meeting:

- The Salisbury Diocese is developing a corporate social responsibility strategy. The Community Foundation is working with the Diocese to promote their Surviving Winter Campaign. £70k was raised last year.
- Diana Pointon presentation on the results of the [2011 'What Matters to You'](#) Wiltshire Household Survey.
- The survey follows on from the 2008 Place Survey and the 2009 Wiltshire Council 20,000 surveys were posted across 20 community areas and was also available on-line and in libraries.
- 16–34 age category underrepresented
- There was a fall in numbers of positive responses to the 'Getting on well together' question and there was a discussion about the validity of responses as the minority groups that may feel less integrated are less likely to answer surveys and so the result could be an anomaly. Also 68% of respondents had lived in Wiltshire 10+ years.
- Data could be analysed at community area level but would not be possible at parish level.
- [VCS Impact Survey 2012](#). The work was carried out by a postgraduate student at Bath University. 800 organisations were sent questionnaires - 20% response rate.
- There is thought to be 7,800 voluntary and community sector organisations in Wiltshire.
- The economic impact of the arts and culture sector is being carried out by Peter Tyas, team manager for arts and archives.
- RCP action plan has been finalised, RCP members to verbally update on outcomes at future meetings
